Day01 Saturday - Mumbai

This evening, arrive at Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus and board your train on a mesmerizing voyage through the Maratha heartland.

Day02 Sunday - Ellora Caves

Proceed to visit Ellora Caves - a World Heritage site. A unique artistic creation, with its sanctuaries devoted to Buddhism, Hinduism and Jainism, it illustrates the spirit of tolerance that was characteristic of ancient India.

Day03 Monday - Aurangabad

Enjoy a day visiting Bibi - Ka - Maqbara a replica of the Taj Mahal at Agra followed by a visit to the famous Himroo fabric weaving centre.

Day04 Tuesday - Pench (Ramtek)

Arrive at Ramtek and drive to Maharashtra's Pench National Park. Named after the Pench River which splits it into almost equal halves, the park is immensely rich in bio-diversity, an important ecosystem supporting an abundance of flora and fauna, including a rich variety of aquatic life. Enjoy morning and afternoon games as far as in the park.

Day05 Wednesday - Tadoba

Reach Chandrapur and set out for the Tadoba Tiger Reserve - A magnificent habitat for the Royal Bengal Tiger. Enjoy lunch at the forest lodge, where the naturalists will interact with you narrating their admirable work in tiger conservation.

Day06 Thursday - Ajanta Caves

Arrive at Pachora railway station and drive to Ajanta Caves, a World Heritage site. These magnificent caves have exquisite ancient murals & sculptures that depict the life of Buddha.

Day07 Friday - Nashik

Arrive at Nashik and walk along the Godavari Ghats; then head for a vineyard tour followed by wine tasting and lunch.

Day08 Saturday - Mumbai

Arrive at Mumbai, where your journey comes to an end.

- We need minimum occupancy to operate all listed journeys, in event if we do not manage minimum occupancy we reserve the right to cancel the journey at least with 45 days prior intimation

CHILD POLICY

- Deccan Odyssey does accommodate children but we ask parents to be mindful of the sophisticated adult atmosphere we endeavor to maintain
- One child up to 5 years of age shall be allowed free of cost in the Deluxe Cabin, subject to sharing of double bed with parents. This is subject to availability of double bed at the time of booking
- For families, with a child between 6-12 years of age, or, with two children with one child below 5 years and another between
- 6-12 years, we recommend the Presidential Suite which has a double bed in the bedroom and can be shared with a child below 5 years and a sofa cum bed in the living room which can accommodate the older child. In this case, the child/children will be accommodated free of cost
- In case of two children between 6-12 years of age travelling with their parents, you will have to take 2 cabins. The first child pays 25% of the adult fare and the second child will have to pay 50% of the adult fare. One of the parents will have to be present with the child / children in the cabin
- Please note that we do not have the facility for interconnecting cabins
- All applicable taxes will be charged extra

PAYMENT:

CANCELLATION:

- Any cancellation must be advised immediately by email (rail@therailjourneys.com) and subsequently confirmed by letter to the Central Reservation Division
